One recent visit stands out for Season. "A couple of us were going door to door offering Bible studies," says Season. "We went to one house that was out of our way. We weren't even supposed to go to it but felt the Holy Spirit leading us."

A man answered the door. His shoulders drooped and he looked forlorn. Soon he shared how his son's mother was an alcoholic and he had serious health problems.

Season spoke up. "I'm a recovered alcoholic. Jesus set me free."

Instantly he turned to face her and a bond was formed. The group prayed with him and promised to return in a week. As they left, they saw a change. Downcast no more, he radiated hope. Today, he is studying the Bible and the Adventist health message.

"It was absolutely divine," says Season. "I can't even imagine what would have happened if we hadn't gone. God has done so much for me and given me a story to share. There are so many, like this man, who need to hear this good news. Who wouldn't want to hear they can have freedom?"
